Rules are being finalized. Sponsors include Silver Lake Marine, Silver Lake Golf Course, Charcoal Corral, & Tackberry Trophies. Each tract is asked to assemble a prize basket.

VI Water Quality Committee

- We continue to attend Silver Lake Watershed Commission Meetings & Wyoming County Soil & Water Resources Committee meetings.
- Upcoming events:

- Water levels have been fluctuating. Adjustments have been made in anticipation of heavy rains, etc. The level dropped 5 inches this past week from 95 to 90 inches.
- There have been mailings in the Institute area about elevated levels of Trihalomethanes. This occurs when water systems have low flow volumes that exist this time of year.
- Silver Lake O U T L E T Dredging
 - Sediment samples from outlet may be taken next week. 10 samples evenly spaced out along the outlet's 2800 ft length
 - \$22K for sampling (SJB)
 - \$9K for analysis (PARADIGM)
 - SLA can secure its own samples and add them to the set and SLA pays its sample analysis ~\$900/sample
 - NO guarantees that we can use our sampling results going forward for DEC permitting
- CSLAP testing results are on website. Overall phosphorus levels are down due to decrease in runoff from dry Summer
- We continue to encourage members to write letters to encourage dredging into the lake. Sample letter are on website.
